Hikes are 1 to 2 miles in length. Guided hikes will meet at 10:30 am at the meeting locations designated below. Guided hikes are \$4 per person or \$10 per family.

Bring sturdy shoes, water, and sun protection to these guided hikes. Guided hikes for Wild Horse Island start at 10:30 am at Skeeko Bay Landing. Guided hikes are \$4 per person or \$10 per family.
