He will be presenting on the traditional cultural landscapes of the Flathead Valley by the indigenous peoples of Montana. A tribal member of the Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Reservation, Tim specializes in the ancestral skills, technologies and traditional ecological knowledge of his tribes. The annual seasonal round depicts the movements and activities of indigenous peoples’ connection with their aboriginal territories. Tim will use maps, history, stories and his recreated artifacts, to tell the story of this place.
